The nominated project should be in Leamington Spa and have been completed within the last two years.

*The competition will be judged by a panel comprising:*

- An external Assessor of recognized standing in the architectural profession
- The Conservation Officer, Warwick District Council
- A professional architect
- The Mayor of Leamington
- The Chairman of the Leamington Society
